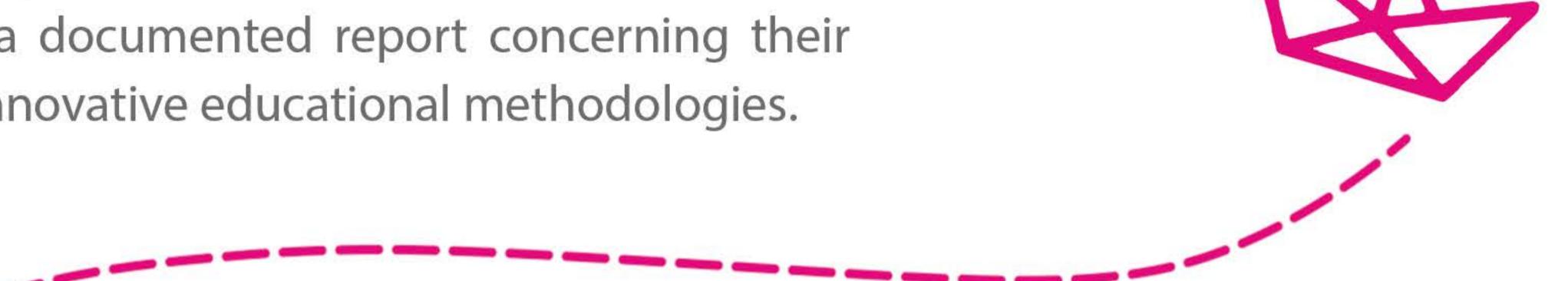

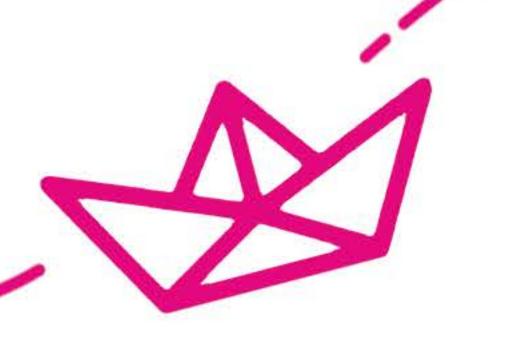

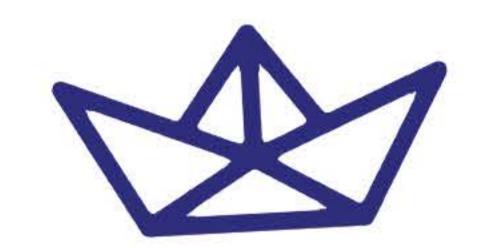


Each partner of our TEMP conducted one Focus Group with their own target group in order to have a broad vision of the topic in the different fields of the formal and non-formal educational systems.





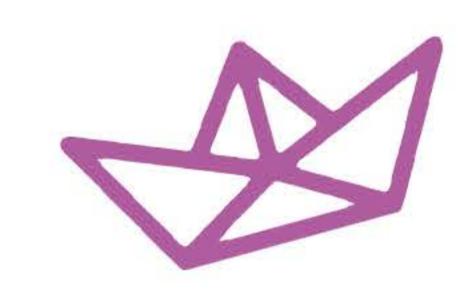
The overall conclusions of the 4 Focus Groups stated that improvements should be made in all four areas of the educational system: curricula, methodologies applied as well as resources and approaches towards the students in order to ensure an appropriated learning process, matching the real needs of fast-changing real world. The necessity of innovative methodologies such as (Personalized learning, Project-Based learning, Real Word learning, Place-based learning) and the importance of STEM learning were highlighted as priorities in ensuring an appropriate and useful teaching and learning trajectory.

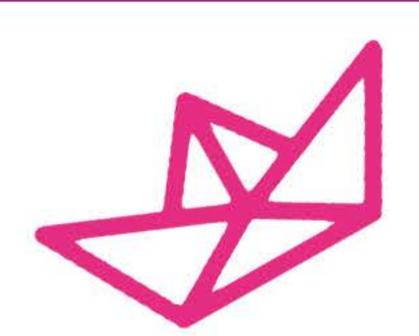


TEMP CONSORTIUM PARTNERS

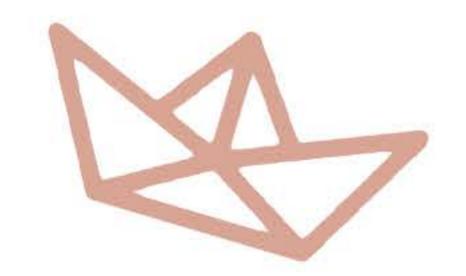


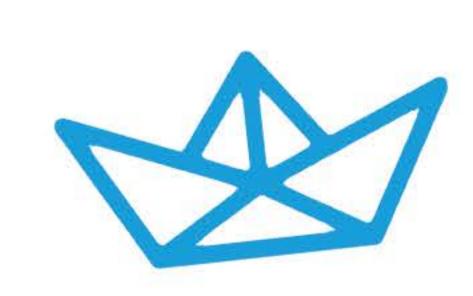


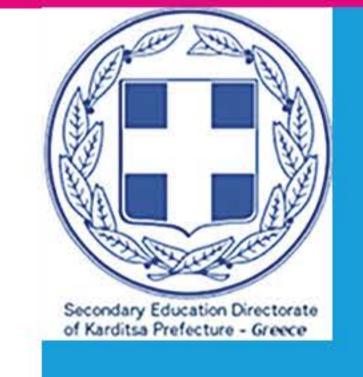
The University of Valladolid conducted the Focus Group with 5 university professors with a broad experience in research and innovation in education.
